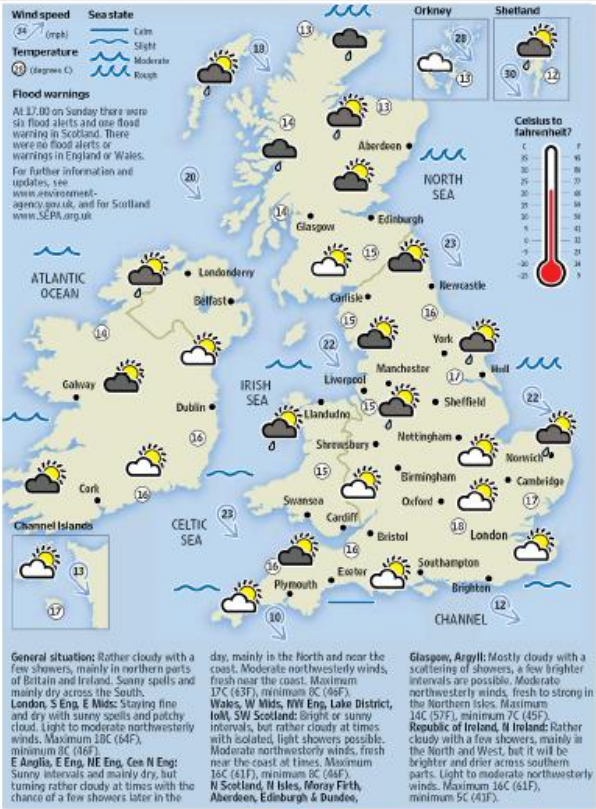

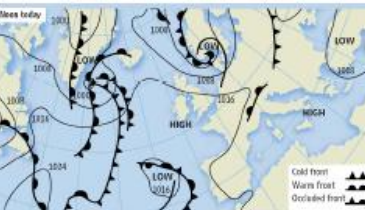

Synoptic situation: An area of low pressure and associated unsettled conditions will move from the North Sea into Scandinavia. A ridge of high pressure will slowly build across Britain from the Atlantic during the day, bringing settled conditions to most places over the next few days. An area of low pressure will approach Scotland from the northwest later in the week.



Spontaneous combustion is a strange and terrifying phenomenon, when things suddenly ignite for what seems to be no apparent reason. Buildings, and even on very rare occasions people, can suddenly go up in flames. And one of the strangest cases of spontaneous combustion happened 260 years ago when the cliffs of Charmouth, Dorset, caught fire. Smoke and flames were seen rising from the cliffs — and to this day, the burning began after heavy rain.

Not far from Weymouth at Ringstead Bay, Dorset, there is actually a place called Burning Cliff, where another fire started in the autumn of 1826. Charles Harper in his book The Dorset Coast, described "a curious outbreak of subterranean fire, which somewhat exercised the minds of the more ignorant and superstitious of the neighbourhood, who began to remember and regret all manner of half-forgotten sins and to wonder how long it would be before Old Scratch claimed them, out of this visible mouth of hell". The burning lasted for about two years and sometimes flames could be seen. "On a calm day the smoke has been seen to rise slowly and with peculiar grandeur, forming a majestic column at least 20 feet in height, producing a curious and imposing effect."

In 1908 the cliffs near Lyme Regis, Dorset, began their own fire from a mound nicknamed "the volcano" and in October the fire increased. "During the past week there has been an increase in the phenomenon of the burning cliffs at Lyme Regis. The heavy rain of the early part of the week caused a considerable movement of the surface, and the volume of smoke which has since emerged has been greater than at any previous time," reported The Times. "The phenomenon of the burning cliffs was caused by oil shale in the rocks. It is thought that after heavy rainfalls, iron pyrite embedded in the oily rocks reacts with oxygen in the air and gives off enough heat to burn the oil. And the smoking holes of the cliffs of Dorset can still be seen on occasions."

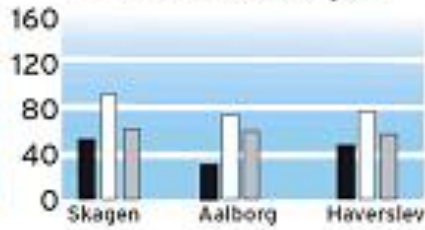
